Look what we've been doing!

The children really enjoyed writing thank you letters to PC Hammond who visited them last week. He came to talk about his job and role in the community. We would like to say a big thank you to Mr Hammond for giving up his time.

The children have been recapping their understanding of what a sentence actually is. They watched short video clips and played sentence games on Espresso. They then went on to write dictated sentences. After that they discussed suffixes and spelt words with -ing and -ed where no change was needed to the root word. They tried to include -ing and -ed words into sentences and sorted -ed words according to their sounds: "d, t, id". On Wednesday the children learnt about plural nouns and adding -s and -es. The children also carried out a comprehension exercise where they were required to answer questions about what they had read.

In Maths this week the children continued to practise subtracting and learning how to bridge ten when taking away. Later in the week they carried out arithmetic and problem solving assessments.

In Science the children created their own plant identification kit and discussed plants in their local environment. They also played a guess the plant bingo game.

On Thursday the whole school took part in an Easter activity day. The children listened to the Easter story and were given the opportunity to try out various Easter themed activities. They visited different classrooms and were taught by teachers from other year groups over the course of the day.
