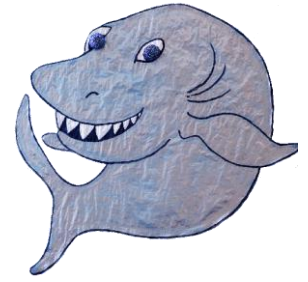

Home learning

As promised, we have provided a folder of activities to keep your children busy during the two week break. Each folder contains some information about the types of

questions children are asked in KS1 SATS reading assessments, the Year 1 and 2 common exception words that the children are expected to read and spell by the end of Year 2. We will be testing the children on some of these during the first week of the summer term. The packs also contain a non-fiction and fiction reading comprehension and a spring maths revision booklet. The children could also practice their arithmetic skills (+, -, x, ÷) using different strategies including column addition and subtraction. This work isn't compulsory but it will keep their skills sharp and help to prepare them for the KS1 SATS in May. They do not have to complete this work independently (some may prefer to do this). Support your children in whatever way you feel necessary but please don't make it a chore and remember to have some fun during the holiday too!

Please ensure that full PE kits are in school on the first day of the summer term as we will be having tennis lessons on Monday afternoon. Don't forget to check that everything fits as we have noticed how quickly the children are growing!
