





Look what we've been doing!



What a lovely week we have all had in the sunshine! In English we read the story of the Tiger Who Came to Tea by Judith Kerr. The children discussed events in the story and then created a story plan. They went on to use their plans to act out the story through role play. Later in the week the children retold The Tiger Who Came to Tea in writing and tried hard to use correct punctuation which remains a focus for this term. As a challenge they also tried to use "and, because" in their writing.

In Maths this week the children continued to practise counting in 2s and 5s. They discussed the patterns and looked at what numbers appear in both the 2 and 5 patterns. They learnt that these numbers are called multiples of 2 and 5. They then solved addition and subtraction word problems. Some of the problems involved the language of fewer and fewest and required the children to apply their subtraction knowledge to find the difference.

The children have been loving Dance this week! They took part in African Zumba and created a circle of life dance. They then finished their session with a "I like to move it" dance based on the dance from the Madagascar DVD.

In the afternoons this week Year One have had Computing lessons. On Monday they started by logging onto the laptops with their own username. They then used Microsoft Word to type their name and learnt how to type a capital letter, leave spaces and start a new line. They also learnt how to log off and shut a computer down. They then went on to use Microsoft Paint to create and draw animals in order to illustrate the story of Noah's Ark.
