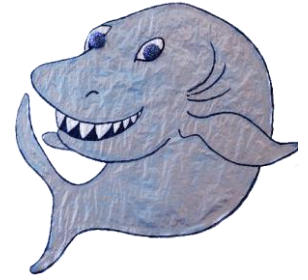

The areas we will be focusing on are:
