

Look what we've been doing!

The children enjoyed visiting their new classes and teachers this week. On Tuesday they spent the morning in Year Two. They did various activities and enjoyed getting to know each other by playing games such as snakes and ladders. They shared their likes and dislikes and discussed what they would like to be when they grow up.

Time was the focus for Maths this week. The children worked practically to make o'clock and half past times and went on to record times on clocks in their books. They also used timers to time each other doing various activities such as writing their names. The children learnt that there are sixty seconds in one minute and sixty minutes in one hour.

In English the children explored books written by David Wiesner. David Wiesner is best known for picture books, including some that tell stories without words. They enjoyed investigating the surreal pictures and tried to work out what was happening in each text. The children shared the books: Flotsam, Tuesday and Free Fall and then tried to retell the story of Flotsam in their own words. They were given the added challenge of trying to include words with taught suffixes such as -ed and -ing.



In Computing the children finished making their e-cards. They were able to retrieve their files and insert saved images. They also learnt how to print their work once finished.

On Tuesday afternoon, the whole school went out on to the field to watch the RAF100 Flypast over the school. The children loved this once in a life time experience and it sparked lots of discussion and work around aeroplanes.
