We have had a very busy week reading Katie Morag stories. The children also learnt about her



life and adventures through watching videos on CBeebies. They wrote character descriptions of Katie Morag and also her two Grandmothers. The children were reminded to use punctuation and were given the challenge of using adjectives for description.

Year One continued to learn about money in Maths. They identified coins and notes and worked out possibilities of paying exactly for items costing 5p, 10p and 20p. As a challenge they tried to pay and give change. The children also practised their counting on skills when playing snakes and ladders in pairs.

The seaside theme continued in Computing as the children were asked to create their own seaside pictures using the program: Paint. They also used iPads to play Maths and English games together.

Both classes played a selection of parachute games in P.E and they had lots of fun working together as a class and we linked this to the values of HIPIP and discussed cooperation and team work.
