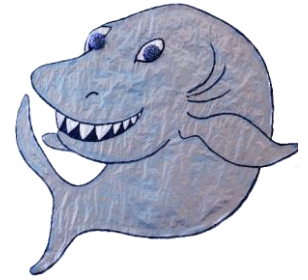


# Year 2
