





Our focus in Guided Reading has been vocabulary. The children are enjoying using the Pawsome Gang to help answer comprehension questions in texts (have a look at the Year 2 bookmarks). We also started using the Amazing Minds mindfulness programme and the children have been given journals to record, in words or pictures, how they are feeling. These will be used at different times of the day.

As part of our school support for training new teachers, both classes participated in demonstration PE lessons, taught by a PE specialist. The children behaved beautifully and have been asked to do a further lesson later in the term.
