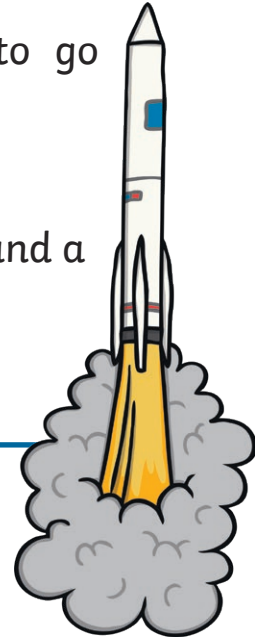
Helen Sharman was the first British person to go into space!

- Helen found space amazing!

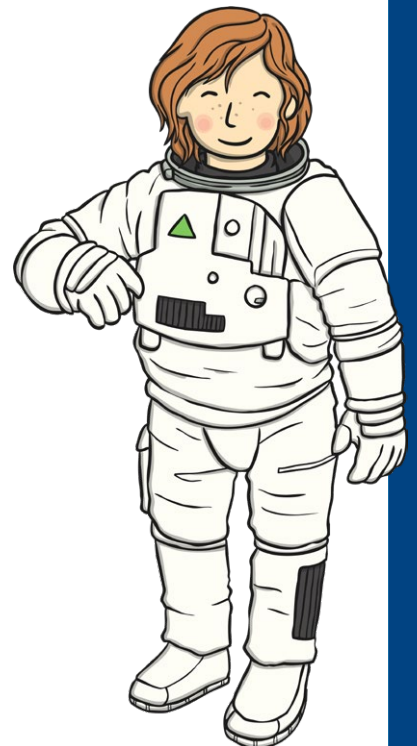


What Has She Done?

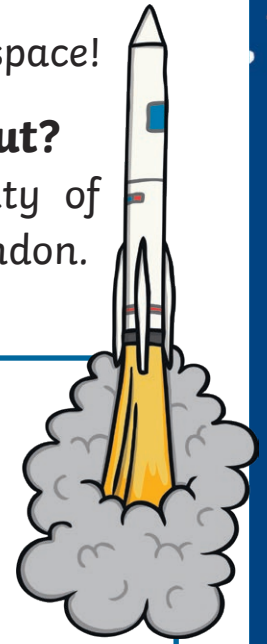

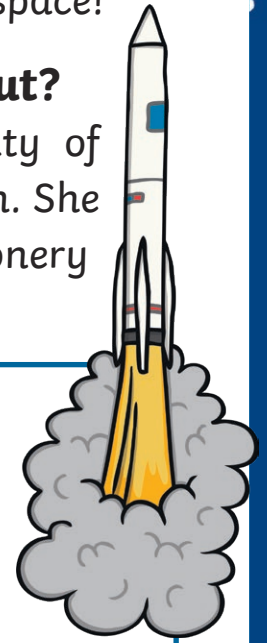

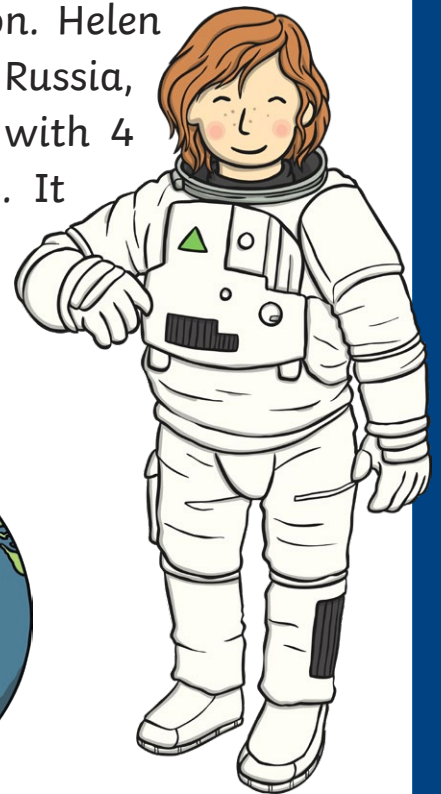

- Helen found it amazing to be up in space and looked out of the window whenever she could!



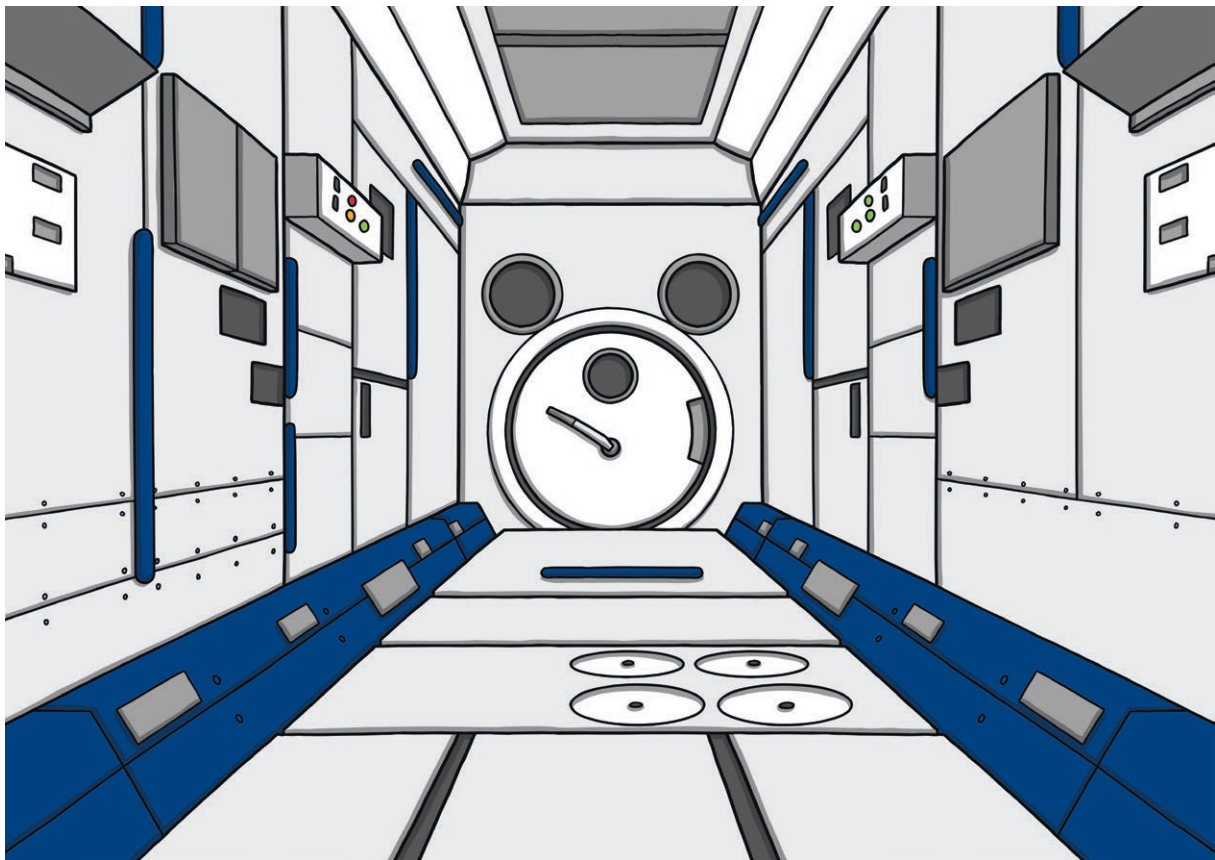
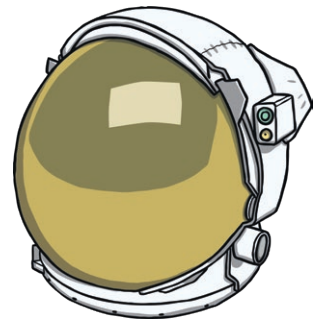
What Has She Achieved?

Helen applied with 13,000 other people to be an astronaut in 1989 after hearing a radio advert looking for astronauts. She had to take many tests and then got the job as part of Project Juno, a commercial British cosmonaut mission. Helen completed 18 months of difficult training in Russia, then became a research cosmonaut working with 4 other astronauts on board the Soyuz TM-12. It launched into space on 18th May 1991 and docked at the space station Mir on 20th May 1991. They returned to Earth aboard Soyuz TM-11 on 26th May 1991. Helen carried out medical and agricultural tests during their eight-day mission. In 1993, she was awarded an OBE from the Queen for her scientific work.



What Is She Remembered For?

Helen is remembered for being an astronaut and a scientist. She is one of only 59 women who have flown in space. Helen was the first ever British astronaut in space, although some people mistakenly think that Major Tim Peake was. She spent some years travelling around the UK discussing her experiences in space, but then chose to keep her life private. Helen now works as an operations manager in the chemistry department at Imperial College London.
