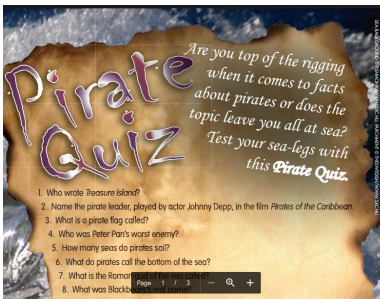


ENGLISH SPaG: Treasure Hunt ([see attachments- treasure hunt](#))
