





Lucky Listener!

Fluency is crucial to a child's reading development and 'Lucky Listener' is a fun way to support reading and fluency at home. Each week your child will bring home a variety of reading material, be it a 'banded' reading book, a 'decodable' reading book, a library book they've chosen for themselves or even some lines to learn for an upcoming assembly or festival. Whatever it is, their challenge is to read the book/a page/an extract aloud to as many listeners as possible. The more they read the same pages/section, the more fluent they will become and with that comes confidence. When a new book comes home, your child might like to hear and follow you read it first and then echo your reading, before moving onto reading by themselves. Every time someone (or something!) listens, they sign the Lucky Listener card.

The signed cards should be brought back into school each week.

Who can be a Lucky Listener? Anyone! At least one parent or carer should be listening and signing off on the Lucky Listener but family friends, siblings, pets and cuddly toys also make great reading buddles too!
