Can you count in steps of 2, 5 and 10?

Can you practise partitioning two-digit numbers? Eg 46 is made of 4 tens (40) and 6 ones (6).	
What information can you find out about the moon? Create a fact file based on what you discover.	
Can you practise writing the year one common exception words?	
Can you draw a picture of an alien?	
What seasonal changes have you noticed? Keep a weather diary for the week.	
Share a book with an adult. This could be a book from school or home.	
What is something you feel proud of? Write it down or draw a picture and share it with your adult.	
Take a few mindful moments. Take some deep breaths and reflect on the week. What was your favourite part? What would you like to change next week?
